Existing law authorizes the commission to collect fees for the inspection, classification, and grading of farm products, fruits, and vegetables.

Existing law authorizes the commission to apply for injunctive relief restraining violations of this Part or institute necessary action for failure to pay accounts due.

New law changes references to commission in existing law to commissioner.

Existing law specifies that injunctive relief restraining violations of this existing law, or necessary actions instituted, may be taken for failure to pay accounts due to the commission.

Existing law provided that the person condemned in any such proceeding is liable for the costs of court and for any additional costs incurred by the commission in gathering the necessary evidence, including reasonable attorney and expert witness fees.

New law changes references to commission in existing law to department.

Effective August 1, 2017.
