7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 11:723(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§723. Members employed in other state employment; exception
10	* * *
11	C. The provisions of this Section shall not be applicable to employees
12	covered by the Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund and the Parochial
13	Employees' Retirement System of Louisiana.
14	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on June 30, 2018; if vetoed by the
15	governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on
16	June 30, 2018, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.

<u>Present law</u> allows a person with at least five years of service credit in the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana (TRSL) to retain membership in that system if the person moves to employment covered by another state or statewide retirement system.

<u>Present law</u> provides that <u>present law</u> ability to retain TRSL membership does not apply to an employee covered by the Parochial Employees' Retirement System (PERS).

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that <u>present law</u> ability to retain TRSL membership is not applicable to an employee covered by the Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund (Clerks').
