BY SENATOR COLOMB

PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS. Names the LSU Health North Clinic and Urgent Care facility in Baton Rouge the "Willie F. Hawkins Emergency Care Center". (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 49:149.33, relative to the names of state buildings; to name the Willie F.
3 Hawkins Emergency Care Center; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 49:149.33 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 **§149.33. Willie F. Hawkins Emergency Care Center**

7 **The state building situated in the city of Baton Rouge, having the**
8 **municipal address of 5439 Airline Highway, and generally known as the LSU**
9 **Health North Clinic and Urgent Care facility, is hereby named and shall**
10 **hereafter be known as the Willie F. Hawkins Emergency Care Center.**

11 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
12 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
13 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
14 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
15 effective on the day following such approval.
