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Abstract: Requires a health benefit plan to note if it is fully insured on identification and coverage documentation.

<u>Present law</u> requires that the identity of a health benefit plan insurer and sponsor be displayed prominently on the face of the identification card or documentation.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> requires every identification card, membership card, insurance coverage card, or other documentation of coverage issued to any policyholder or health plan participant by a health insurer for a plan that is fully insured to include the phrase "Non-ERISA" prominently displayed on the face of the card or other documentation.

Proposed law changes the required phrase to "Fully Insured".

Effective Jan. 1, 2019.
