Present law defines "child" as any person under the age of 21, including an emancipated minor, who commits a delinquent act before attaining 17 years of age.

Present law provides that after June 30, 2018, "child" shall mean any person under the age of 21, including an emancipated minor, who commits a delinquent act on or after July 1, 2018, when the act is not a crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2, and occurs before the person attains 18 years of age.

Proposed law changes the effective date of present law to provide that after June 30, 2019, "child" shall mean any person under the age of 21, including an emancipated minor, who commits a delinquent act on or after July 1, 2019, when the act is not a crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2, and occurs before the person attains 18 years of age.

Effective June 1, 2018.
