Walsworth

<u>Present law</u> defines "child" as any person under the age of 21, including an emancipated minor, who commits a delinquent act before attaining 17 years of age.

<u>Present law</u> provides that after June 30, 2018, "child" shall mean any person under the age of 21, including an emancipated minor, who commits a delinquent act on or after July 1, 2018, when the act is not a crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2, and occurs before the person attains 18 years of age.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the effective date of <u>present law</u> to provide that after June 30, 2019, "child" shall mean any person under the age of 21, including an emancipated minor, who commits a delinquent act on or after July 1, 2019, when the act is not a crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2, and occurs before the person attains 18 years of age.

Effective June 1, 2018.
