CIVIL PROCEDURE. Authorizes business entities to assert or defend certain claims on their own behalf. (gov sig)

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 37:212(C), relative to the practice of law; to provide definitions
3	and exceptions; to provide relative to the assertion or defense of claims by a legal
4	entity; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 37:212(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§212. "Practice of law" defined
8	* * *
9	C. Nothing in this Section shall prohibit any partnership, corporation, or other
10	legal entity from asserting or defending any claim, not exceeding five twenty-five
11	thousand dollars, on its own behalf in the courts of limited jurisdiction or on its own
12	behalf through a duly authorized partner, shareholder, officer, employee, or duly
13	authorized agent or representative. No partnership, corporation, or other entity may
14	assert any claim on behalf of another entity or any claim assigned to it.
15	* * *
16	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
17	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature

- by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
- 2 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
- 3 effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Present law</u> defines the "practice of law". Provides that nothing in <u>present law</u> shall prohibit any person from attending to or caring for his own business, claims, or demands. Further provides that any partnership, corporation, or other legal entity can assert or defend any claim, not exceeding \$5,000, on its own behalf in the courts of limited jurisdiction or on its own behalf through a duly authorized partner, shareholder, officer, employee, or duly authorized agent, or representative.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes above amount  $\underline{\text{from}}$  \$5,000  $\underline{\text{to}}$  \$25,000 and retains remainder of <u>present law</u>.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
