PHARMACEUTICALS. Provides relative to access to prescription monitoring information.

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AN ACT

To enact R.S. 40:1007(E)(8), relative to access to prescription monitoring information; to provide for access by certain Louisiana Department of Health epidemiologists; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 40:1007(E)(8) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§1007. Access to prescription monitoring information and audit trail information

**(8) An epidemiologist with the Louisiana Department of Health for the purpose of assisting the board in analyzing prescription monitoring information in order to conduct public health evaluations to support public policy and education pursuant to an agreement with the board.**
