Abstract: Prohibits the use of privately owned copying devices in the office of a district attorney (DA) unless DA or court approves their use; authorizes a DA to change fees for redaction and copying of records.

Proposed law prohibits the use of privately owned copying devices in the DA's office unless ordered by a court or approved by the DA.

Proposed law authorizes the DA to charge a fee for redaction of records prior to copying them and for making copies.
