**Abstract:** Removes the threshold amount of \$200,000 of goods and services furnished per year for which non-gaming suppliers must obtain a permit.

<u>Present law</u> requires non-gaming suppliers who furnish goods or services in excess of \$200,000 per year to a gaming operator or slot machine or riverboat gaming licensee to obtain a non-gaming supplier permit issued by the Gaming Control Board.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the threshold amount of \$200,000 in <u>present law</u> and provides that nongaming suppliers of goods and services must obtain a permit as provided by rules of the board regardless of the amount of goods or services furnished.
