**Abstract:** Provides for a motion to recoup child support payments made when the mover was deceived as to the paternity of a child.

Proposed law authorizes the filing of a motion by a man to recover child supports made when he has been intentionally deceived into believing that he is the biological father of a child. Provides for the conditions in which the motion shall be granted and provides for a rebuttable presumption.

Proposed law provides that the motion to recoup child support payments allows the mover to recover all support paid, as well as attorney fees and court costs.
