HOUSE BILL NO. 489

MOTOR VEHICLES: Requires the Used Motor Vehicle Commission to report information collected by salvage pools and salvage disposal sales

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 32:808(C) and R.S. 47:1508(B)(42), relative to reporting requirements  
3 imposed on the Louisiana Used Motor Vehicle Commission; to require reporting of  
4 certain information regarding salvage pools and salvage disposal sales; to authorize  
5 the sharing of information; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 32:808(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §808. Salvage pools; record keepers

9 \* \* \*

10 C.(1) For each transaction fee collected pursuant to Subsection B of this  
11 Section, the commission shall report monthly by electronic mail or any other  
12 reasonable manner to the Department of Revenue all of the register information kept  
13 by the salvage pool or salvage disposal sale as required pursuant to Subsection A of  
14 this Section.

15 (2) The Department of Revenue, by the discretion of its secretary, is  
16 authorized to share with or furnish to the commission any information either  
17 collected or retained in accordance with the provisions of this Section.

18 (3) The commission shall promulgate any rules or regulations necessary to  
19 implement and enforce the provisions of this Section no later than January 1, 2019.

1 Section 2. R.S. 47:1508(B)(41) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

2 §1508. Confidentiality of tax records

4 B. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to prevent:

6 (42) The sharing or furnishing, at the discretion of the secretary, of  
7 information to the Louisiana Used Motor Vehicle Commission pursuant to the  
8 provisions of R.S. 32:808 for the purposes of the collection and retention of registry  
9 information relative to the sale of motor vehicles by the owner, manager, or person  
10 in charge of a salvage pool.

DIGEST

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**Abstract:** Requires the La. Used Motor Vehicle Commission to report certain information collected from salvage pools and salvage disposal sales transactions.

Present law (R.S. 32:808(B)) provides that when a bid card is not required in order to purchase a vehicle, a transaction fee of five dollars shall be collected and remitted monthly, electronically or otherwise, and transmitted to the commission by the owner or operator of the salvage pool in connection with the sale of each vehicle.

Proposed law requires the La. Used Motor Vehicle Commission to report monthly to the Dept. of Revenue certain information for each transaction fee collected pursuant to present law.

Proposed law requires the information to include a register of all sales of motor vehicles for three years from the date of sale, showing the make, model, year, body style, vehicle identification number, odometer reading, and the name and address of the seller and buyer. Salvage pools and salvage disposal sales are required to keep this information pursuant to present law.

Proposed law authorizes the dept., in the discretion of its secretary, to share with or furnish to the commission any information either collected or retained in accordance with the provisions of proposed law.

Proposed law requires the commission to promulgate any rules or regulations necessary to implement and enforce the provisions of proposed law no later than Jan. 1, 2019.
