<u>Present law</u> requires the Medicaid Subcommittee of the Health and Social Services Estimating Conference to develop forecasts of the Medicaid Program and to submit forecasts to the conference. <u>Proposed law</u> requires the Medicaid Subcommittee to submit adopted forecasts to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget for review at the next meeting following submission of the forecast.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Proposed law places the Medicaid forecast on the agenda of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget (JLCB) for review the month following adoption of the forecast by the Medicaid Subcommittee. Since the proposed legislation requires the JLCB to review the Medicaid forecast in the course of its normal business, there should be no additional expenditures associated with per diem and mileage costs for committee members.
