14	(e) The subcommittee shall submit each adopted forecast to the Joint

following the submission by the subcommittee.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the Medicaid Subcommittee on the Health and Social Services Estimating Conference to develop forecasts of the Medicaid program and submit those forecasts and reports on it actions to the conference.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further requires the subcommittee to submit the adopted forecasts to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget for review at the next meeting of the committee following the submission of the forecast.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
