Subject: Increase Fees for Accident Reports Exceeding Two (2) Pages Analyst: Ryan Guidry

TRAFFIC/VIOLATIONS OR +\$900,000 SG RV See Note Changes the fee applicable to certain accident reports

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<u>Present law</u> requires state police, any local police department, or any sheriff's office to provide copies of crash reports upon request to any interested person and authorizes a fee of \$5 per report that does not exceed two pages, and \$7.50 per report that exceeds two pages.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the fee for reports that exceed two pages <u>from</u> \$7.50 <u>to</u> \$20. <u>Proposed law</u> changes "crash report" to "accident report."

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The Department of Public Safety (DPS) reports that the proposed legislation will require a vendor contract in the amount of \$2,500 for one-time upgrades to existing software and systems to reflect the new \$20 fee. The Legislative Fiscal Office believes that the department can potentially accomplish these tasks utilizing existing resources and budget authority. To the extent that numerous pieces of legislation are enacted that require additional programming efforts, DPS may require additional resources.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> will increase the fee for accident reports that exceed two pages by \$12.50, <u>from</u> \$7.50 <u>to</u> \$20 for state police, local police departments, and sheriff's offices.

For DPS, <u>proposed law</u> will generate an additional \$900,000 per year (72,000 annual reports * \$12.50) for a 5-year total increase of \$4.5 million. DPS reports that it generates 72,000 accident reports per year on average, and due to the format of the report, all accident reports exceed two pages.

Furthermore, the <u>proposed law</u> will increase local revenues by an indeterminable amount for all local police departments and sheriff's offices with the exception of those located within Orleans parish which already have authority under R.S. 32:398(K) (1)(b) to charge up to \$20 for providing copies of accident reports. For all other local police departments and sheriff's departments, revenues will increase by \$12.50 for each accident report that exceeds two pages.
