Requires public schools to provide information relative to influenza and immunization against the influenza virus

Proposed legislation requires public and non-public local governing authorities to provide parents and legal guardians with information relative to the risks associated with influenza including the causes and symptoms, the means by which it is spread, as well as where to obtain additional information and immunizations. Requires the Department of Education to provide information to parents of students enrolled in home study programs approved by BESE. Requires the Department of Health to develop and provide such information updated annually if new information becomes available. Requires the Department of Health in consultation with the Department of Education to establish guidelines in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act. Further applies the requirements to charter schools and non public schools.
