Boudreaux

<u>Present law</u> prohibits taking certain contraband into state-owned and administered hospitals. Proposed law is applicable to all hospitals.

<u>Present law</u> identifies one form of contraband prohibited in hospitals as narcotic or hypnotic drugs that create a hypnotic effect if taken internally. <u>Proposed law</u> modernizes this definition to include any controlled dangerous substance that has not been prescribed or recommended in accordance with the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law.
