**Abstract:** Prohibits an employer from mandating forced arbitration in sexual harassment or veteran discrimination claims.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits intentional discrimination in employment against a veteran, intentional discrimination due to race, color, religion, sex, or national origin and provides for penalties for violations.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits an employer from requiring an employee to sign a contract that would force arbitration in the instance of a sexual harassment claim or a claim of discrimination against a veteran. <u>Proposed law</u> otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Labor and Industrial Relations</u> to the original bill:

1. Prohibit any employer from including a clause in any employment contract that would force arbitration in a dispute for discrimination brought by a veteran for unlawful discrimination in employment because of the employee's veteran status.
