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Revises certain provisions of the Safe Haven Law

Present law provides a mechanism by which any parent may anonymously relinquish an infant that is not more than 60 days old at a designated emergency care facility. Present law provides a definition of a designated emergency care facility. Proposed law revises the definition of a designated emergency care facility. Proposed law adds that a designated emergency care facility may post instructions to contact 911 for a relinquishment outside of normal operating hours.
