15	(2)(a) It is the intent of the legislature that, for the purposes of this Section,
16	"sex education" shall mean the dissemination of factual biological or pathological
17	information that is related to the human reproduction system and may include the
18	study of sexually transmitted disease, pregnancy, childbirth, puberty, menstruation,
19	and menopause, as well as the dissemination of factual information about parental
20	responsibilities under the child support laws of the state. It is the intent of the
21	legislature that "sex education" shall not include religious beliefs, practices in human
22	sexuality, nor the subjective moral and ethical judgments of the instructor or other
	persons. Students shall not be tested, quizzed, or surveyed about their personal or
24	family beliefs or practices in about sex, morality, or religion.
23 24 25 26	(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subparagraph (a) of this
26	Paragraph, the following may survey high school students anonymously about
27	their risk behavior associated with chronic health conditions, including those
27 28	related to sexual health:
29	(i) The state Department of Education.
30	(ii) The Department of Health.
31	(c) Prior to the administration of any survey authorized by the provisions
32	of Subparagraph (b) of this Paragraph, a student's parent or legal guardian
33	shall be provided the opportunity to request that the student be excused from
34	completing the survey. Upon such request, the student shall neither be given nor

be required to complete the survey.
