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1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "enact" and before "relative" delete "R.S. 4:65(A)(4) and 85(9)," and  
3 insert in lieu thereof "R.S. 4:61(G) and 65(A)(4),"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, at the end of line 7, delete "R.S. 4:65(A)(4) and" and insert in lieu thereof "R.S.  
6 4:61(G) and 65(A)(4)"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, at the beginning of line 8, delete "85(9)"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 1, between lines 8 and 9, insert the following:

11           "§61. State Boxing and Wrestling Commission; domicile; authority

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14                       G. The commission, the individual members of the commission, and the state  
15 of Louisiana shall not be liable for damages in any civil action for any event which  
16 is promoted pursuant to R.S. 4:83(B).

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20 AMENDMENT NO. 5

21 On page 1, line 13, after "wrestling" delete the remainder of the line, delete line 14 in its  
22 entirety, and insert in lieu thereof "promoter who, during the calendar year the promoter's  
23 license is granted, promotes exclusively events authorized by R.S. 4:83(B)."

24 AMENDMENT NO. 6

25 On page 1, delete lines 19 and 20 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

26           "B. The provisions of R.S. 4:65(A)(2), 67(A) and (B), 68 through 70, 72, 73,  
27 and 79(C) shall not apply to any professional wrestling event provided all of the  
28 following conditions are met:"

29 AMENDMENT NO. 7

30 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 16 in their entirety and insert the following:

31           "(1)The promoter and all the participants are licensed pursuant to  
32 R.S.4:65(A)(1) and (B).

33           (2) The venue for the event is either a primary or secondary school  
34 gymnasium or has a capacity of four hundred persons or less as certified by the state  
35 fire marshal.

1           (3) There is present at each such event, from the start of the event until the  
2 finish of the event, an individual of the full age of majority, who is not a participant  
3 in the event, who has documented current certification in Infant/Child/Adult CPR.

4           (4) The promoter secures a commercial liability policy for a minimum of one  
5 hundred thousand dollars or provides proof to the secretary of the commission that  
6 the venue provides a liability policy in that amount, which policy shall be in full  
7 force and effect at the time of the event.

8           (5) All applicable provisions of this Chapter and the rules and regulations for  
9 the commission are observed and obeyed during the event.

10          (6) The promoter provides written notice to the secretary of the commission  
11 no less than fifteen days prior to the event which certifies the compliance with  
12 Paragraphs (1) through (5) of this Subsection and includes verifying documents.

13           C. The following shall apply to any professional wrestling event conducted  
14 pursuant to Subsection B of this Section:

15           (1) The promoter shall not be required by the commission to pay any show  
16 date reservation fee nor shall any fee be charged for submission of the written notice  
17 pursuant to R.S. 4:83(B)(6).

18           (2) A promoter shall not be required by the commission to purchase health  
19 insurance for the event.

20           (3) Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, the commission shall not  
21 be required to have any representative present at the event.

22           (4) The promoter shall at all times be responsible at the event for compliance  
23 with the applicable provisions of this Chapter and the rules and regulations of the  
24 commission.

25           (5) The promoter shall, within the fifteen days following the show, report in  
26 writing the results of each event."
