PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS EG SEE FISC NOTE LF EX See Note Provides with respect to group purchasing of materials, equipment, and supplies

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<u>Present law</u> authorizes any public school district or public school to enter into an agreement with a group purchasing organization for the purchase of materials, equipment and supplies, including any installation thereof; requires that any such agreement requires the organization to submit a price list and that prices quoted remain in effect for a stated period of time, not less than three months; requires that any such price list be considered a valid and binding bid; provides that the price list shall not be a public record; and authorizes a school board to purchase equipment from a qualified group purchasing organization if the price is less than that for the same or substantially similar equipment on the state bid list.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that price lists become public record when the purchase contract is executed; authorizes school boards to purchase materials, equipment or supplies from or through a group purchasing organization if there is no applicable state contract or bid list or if the price is lower; and authorizes public school districts and public schools to consider a previously submitted price list to be a valid and binding bid for such solicitation.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

<u>Proposed law</u> may result in a nominal decrease of local funds expenditures if certain education-related governmental entities utilize group purchasing to acquire lower prices for materials, equipment or supplies. <u>Proposed law</u> expands and clarifies <u>present law</u>, allowing school boards to purchase from group purchasing organizations without bid if there is no state contract available. <u>Proposed law</u> clarifies that school districts and public schools may use group purchasing organizations directly. Proposed law allows consideration of a prior price list to be accepted as a valid bid, even if a newer price list is available.
