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Prohibits the intentional damaging or tampering of a tracking device on certain motor vehicles
Proposed law creates the crime of criminal damage to a tracking device, which prohibits any person from intentionally damaging or tampering with a tracking device installed on or attached to a motor vehicle that is rented or leased from a used motor vehicle dealer or that is acquired through a motor vehicle credit transaction while there still exists an unpaid balance on such transaction.

## EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law may result in an indeterminable increase in local funds expenditures for local governing authorities as a result of a first conviction for intentionally damaging or tampering with a tracking device installed on or attached to certain motor vehicles. A first conviction is a misdemeanor with a maximum imprisonment term of six (6) months at the local level.

Proposed law may result in an indeterminable increase in SGF expenditures in the Department of Public Safety and Corrections - Corrections Services as a result of second or subsequent convictions of individuals being convicted of intentionally damaging or tampering with a tracking device installed on or attached to certain motor vehicles. The conviction shall result in individuals being imprisoned, with or without hard labor, for a maximum of 1 year.

SGF expenditures will increase by $\$ 54.21$ per offender per day if an offender is housed in a state facility or $\$ 24.39$ for a state offender housed in a local facility. An offender sentenced to the custody of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections Correction Services for one year would increase SGF expenditures by $\$ 19,786.65$ ( $\$ 54.21$ per day $\times 365$ days) if housed in a state facility and $\$ 8,902.35$ ( $\$ 24.39$ per day $\times 365$ days) if housed in a local facility. Approximately $50 \%$ of state offenders are housed in state facilities and approximately $50 \%$ of state offenders are housed in local facilities.

## REVENUE EXPLANATION

Proposed law may result in an indeterminable increase in local revenues if an individual is convicted of intentionally damaging or tampering with a tracking device installed on or attached to certain motor vehicles. Proposed law provides for a maximum fine of $\$ 1,000$.
