NOTARIES: Provides relative to ex officio notaries for coroners

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 35:416, relative to ex officio notaries for coroners; to provide for the  
3 qualifications, appointment, and authority of ex officio notaries for coroners; to  
4 provide for bond requirements; to provide for limitations and termination of the  
5 authority of ex officio notaries; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 35:416 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §416. Ex officio notaries for coroners

9 A. Notwithstanding any provisions of the law relative to qualifications for  
10 notaries public, each coroner may designate one deputy or assistant per shift for each  
11 office location and appoint them as ex officio notaries public.

12 B.(1) The deputy or assistant so appointed may exercise, in the parish which  
13 the coroner serves, the functions of a notary public only to administer oaths and  
14 execute affidavits, acknowledgments, and other documents, all limited to matters  
15 within the official functions of the office of coroner. For each such action, the notary  
16 shall use the official seal of that respective coroner's office.

17 (2) He shall fulfill the same bond requirements as provided by law for  
18 notaries in the parish which the coroner serves.

19 (3) The coroner shall pay as an expense of his office the costs of the notarial  
20 seal, the notarial bond, and any fees required for filing the bond.

- 1           C. All acts performed by such an ex officio notary public authorized by this  
2           Section shall be performed without charge or other compensation.
- 3           D. The coroner may suspend or terminate an appointment made pursuant to  
4           this Section at any time, and separation from the employ of the coroner shall  
5           automatically terminate the powers of such an ex officio notary public.

**Abstract:** Authorizes coroners to appoint a deputy coroner or an assistant within their respective offices as ex officio notaries public.

Proposed law authorizes each coroner to designate one deputy or assistant per shift for each office location and appoint them as ex officio notaries public.

Proposed law provides that each deputy or assistant so appointed may exercise, in the parish which the coroner serves, certain functions of a notary public limited to matters within the official functions of the office of coroner.

Proposed law provides procedures for the use of the official seal, requires the posting of bond, and prohibits compensation for the notarial services.

Proposed law authorizes the coroner to suspend or terminate an appointment, and provides that separation from employment shall automatically terminate the powers of the ex officio notary public.
