3 members of boards and commissions; to provide for definitions; to provide an
4 exception for members of certain boards and commissions; and to provide for related

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Limit the exemption provided in proposed law to neighborhood security and improvement boards or commissions that do not have the authority to expend, disperse, or invest more than \$500,000 of funds in a fiscal year.
