## Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to the original bill

- 3. Provides that LDH may approve training programs for retail food establishments that sell only prepackaged food items and shall instruct and educate the owner or his designee of the requirements and enforcement provisions of the law.
- 4. Makes technical corrections.
