a list of those commercial fishermen and charter fishing guides who possess a

commercial fisherman's license having a "certified" endorsement.

Abstract: Provides for certification of a charter boat guide as earning more than 50% of their income from charter boat guide activities.

<u>Present law</u> requires the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to certify a commercial fisherman's license upon receipt of a notarized statement stating that the fisherman earns at least 50% of his income from commercial fishing activities. Requires the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to maintain a list of those commercial fishermen with certified licenses.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds charter boat guides to <u>present law</u> and includes them in the certification program.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

(Amends R.S. 56:303(E))
