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Abstract: Establishes a neonatal opiate withdrawal syndrome pilot project.

<u>Proposed law</u> creates a neonatal opiate withdrawal syndrome pilot project within the La. Dept. of Health (LDH).

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes the duties of LDH in implementing the pilot project.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the pilot project to be an evidence-based pilot project conducted by a multidisciplinary team to treat infants with neonatal opiate withdrawal syndrome by providing care options that are safe alternatives to the intensive care unit in existing community or hospital settings for eligible mother-infant dyads.

Proposed law adds that the pilot project is subject to specific appropriation by the legislature.
