DIGEST 2018 Regular Session

<u>Present law</u> provides that retirement benefits provided by the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System (MPERS) shall not annually exceed 100% of average compensation. Provides that when a member has earned benefits equal to 100% of his average compensation, no further contributions shall be required of the employee. Specifies that the employer shall continue to pay to the system the employer's contribution.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> maximum annual retirement benefit of 100% of average compensation. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that once a member has earned benefits equal to 100% of his average compensation, no further contributions shall be required of the employer. Requires the employee to pay the employer's contribution in lieu of the employee contribution if he continues his employment.
