Creates a task force to study issues related to teacher shortages in Louisiana

Present law creates the Task Force on Teacher Shortages to research strategies to overcome the state's teacher shortage challenge and secure a stronger educator workforce. Provides for the membership of the task force; provides for the superintendent of education to designate staff to assist the task force and to call the initial meeting no later than 8/1/2018; requires a written report with findings and recommendations be submitted to the House and Senate Committees on Education and BESE no later than 12/31/2018. Further specifies the recommendations shall include but not be limited to information on shortages by subject area, grade level and geographic area; retention; and other states' practices on hiring, preparation, recruitment and retention.
