DIGEST

Present constitution prohibits the loan, pledge, or donation of funds, credit, property, or things of value of the state. Provides an extensive list of exceptions to this prohibition.

Proposed constitutional amendment retains present constitution and adds an exception that, pursuant to written agreement, permits the use of public equipment and personnel by a political subdivision upon the request of another political subdivision for an activity or power which the requesting political subdivision is authorized to exercise.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held on November 6, 2018.
