Subject: Prohibits possession or carrying a concealed weapon firearm

WEAPONS/FIREARMS OR SEE FISC NOTE GF EX

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Prohibits a person convicted of a hate crime from possessing a firearm or carrying a concealed weapon

Proposed law prohibits individuals convicted of a hate crime from possessing a firearm or carrying a concealed weapon. Proposed law provides for criminal penalties and exceptions. Proposed law defines "firearm" and provides for related matters.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law may result in an indeterminable increase in SGF expenditures in the Department of Public Safety and Corrections – Corrections Services if a certain person convicted of a hate crime is subsequently convicted of possession of a firearm or carrying of a concealed weapon. The maximum imprisonment term is five (5) years, with or without hard labor.

SGF expenditures will increase by \$54.21 per offender per day if an offender is housed in a state facility or \$24.39 for a state offender housed in a local facility. An offender sentenced to the custody of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections -Correction Services for one year would increase SGF expenditures by \$19,786.65 (\$54.21 per day x 365 days) if housed in a state facility and \$8,902.35 (\$24.39 per day x 365 days) if housed in a local facility. Approximately 50% of state offenders are housed in state facilities and approximately 50% of state offenders are housed in local facilities.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Proposed law may result in an indeterminable increase in local funds revenue as a result of potential fines if certain persons convicted of a hate crime is subsequently convicted of possession of a firearm or carrying of a concealed weapon. The maximum fines assessed are \$1,000. The potential revenue will accrue to the local governing authority.
