MTR VEHICLE/LICEN PLATES: Decreases the minimum number of applicants required for the issuance of the United States Merchant Marine Academy special prestige license plate

AN ACT
To amend and reenact R.S. 47:463.189(A), relative to the United States Merchant Marine Academy; to reduce the minimum number of applicants for the United States Merchant Marine Academy specialty plate; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 47:46.189(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: §463.189. Special prestige license plate; United States Merchant Marine Academy, Kings Point
A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate for the United States Merchant Marine Academy, provided there is a minimum of one hundred applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks, vans, and recreational vehicles.
