PORTS/SOUTH LOUISIANA: Provides relative to per diems for the Port of South Louisiana Commission

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 34:2472(D), relative to the Port of South Louisiana Commission;  
3 to provide for per diems for commission members when performing duties  
4 authorized by the board; to provide for a maximum per diem for commission  
5 members not to exceed the federal employee authorized per diem; and to provide for  
6 related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 34:2472(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

9 §2472. Officers of the board; meetings

10 \* \* \*

11 D. The commission may authorize in its bylaws the payment of a per diem,  
12 not to exceed the federal employee authorized per diem, to each commissioner for  
13 attendance at officially called meetings or any subcommittee meetings of the board  
14 of commissioners, or when a commissioner is performing duties or engaging in  
15 activities authorized by the board of commissioners. ~~not to exceed the federal~~  
16 ~~employee authorized per diem.~~

**Abstract:** Provides a per diem to each commissioner of the Port of South La. Commission when performing duties authorized by the board of commissioners.

Present law provides a per diem to each commissioners of the Port of South La. Commission for attendance at officially called meetings or any subcommittee meetings of the board of commissioners not to exceed the federal employee authorized per diem.

Proposed law modifies present law by adding that a commissioner may receive a per diem when performing duties or engaging in activities authorized by the board of commissioners. Also, provides for a maximum per diem for commission members not to exceed the federal employee authorized per diem.
