**Abstract:** Provides for general smoking prohibitions, definitions, and penalties.

Present law provides for definitions relative to the La. Smoke Free Air Act.

Proposed law adds to defining terms relative to the La. Smoke Free Air Act.

Present law provides for areas in which smoking is prohibited. Proposed law adds to areas in which smoking is prohibited.

Present law provides for areas in which smoking is allowed. Proposed law adds to areas in which smoking is allowed.

Present law provides for smoking violation penalties. Proposed law adds to the list of violations.

Proposed law provides that any provision of proposed law held to be invalid or unenforceable by its terms, or as applied to any person or circumstance, shall be construed so as to give it the maximum effect permitted by law, unless such holding is one of utter invalidity or unenforceability, in which event the provision shall be deemed severable and shall not affect the remainder of proposed law or the application of such provision to other persons not similarly situated or to other dissimilar circumstances.

Proposed law is effective Jan. 2, 2019.
