<u>Present law</u> provides requirements for a manufacturer, dealer-distributor, user, blaster, or handler of explosives to obtain a state-issued license.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds the requirement of proof of a \$50 million liability insurance policy to cover damage caused by blast waves, blast wind, fire, fragmentation, open burning, secondary fragmentation, shockwaves, and stress waves as a condition of issuance of a license when the applicant is in control of demilitarized explosives, propellants, and recycled bomb materials in excess of one-half million pounds.

Proposed law excludes federal military installations from proposed law.

Effective August 1, 2018.
