- On page 1, line 9, after "property," delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 10
 through 16 and insert:
 - "under either of the following circumstances:

(1) The offender's criminal negligence causes the fire or the explosion.
 (2) The offender's conduct, whether or not amounting to criminal negligence, causes the fire or the explosion and the offender fails to report the fire or the explosion, as soon as reasonably possible, to the proper authorities, including any law enforcement agency, fire department, or emergency services agency within the jurisdiction in which the property is located.

11B. If the offender knows or should have known that he has no possessory12right to the property or other interest therein, or has not previously established13a right of entry into or onto the property, it may be inferred that the setting of14the fire or the causing of the explosion was without consent of the owner or15custodian of the property.

16C. Whoever commits the crime of negligent arson where it is not17foreseeable that human life might be endangered shall be subject to the18following:"

29	restitution for damages sustained.
30	E. Whoever commits the crime of negligent arson resulting in death or
31	serious bodily injury to a human being shall be fined not more than five
32	thousand dollars and imprisoned, with or without hard labor, for not more than
33	five years. In addition, the offender shall be ordered to pay restitution for
34	<u>damages sustained. For the purposes of this Subsection, "serious bodily injury"</u>
35	<u>means bodily injury that involves unconsciousness, extreme physical pain or</u>
36	protracted and obvious disfigurement, or protracted loss or impairment of the
37	<u>function of a bodily member, organ, or mental faculty, or a substantial risk of</u>
38	<u>death.</u> "
