SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 89

SPECIAL DISTRICTS. Designates April 11, 2018 as Tourism Day.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To designate April 11, 2018, as Tourism Day at the Louisiana State Capitol.
3	WHEREAS, 2016 was the fifth consecutive record-breaking year in tourism with
4	forty-six million seven hundred thousand people visiting Louisiana and spending a total of
5	sixteen billion eight hundred million dollars; and
6	WHEREAS, 2016 visitor expenditures resulted in over one billion dollars in state tax
7	revenue; and
8	WHEREAS, the revenue generated from domestic and international visitors
9	represents a remarkable forty-to-one return on investment of state funding of the Department
10	of Culture, Recreation and Tourism, office of tourism; and
11	WHEREAS, tourism employment ranked fourth in the number of jobs created in
12	2016, and travel spending supports two hundred thirty-one thousand five hundred sixty-
13	seven jobs in Louisiana; and
14	WHEREAS, no state general funds are appropriated for tourism and tourism is
15	funded exclusively by a dedication of three one-hundredths of a cent of sales tax; and
16	WHEREAS, the funds generated by this dedication have been and continue to be
17	used by the office of tourism to promote tourism in our state, and as a result they create
18	enormous economic impact; and

1	WHEREAS, the Louisiana Travel Promotion Association board of directors, on
2	behalf of the more than seven hundred fifty tourism professional members of the association,
3	recommends that the office of tourism be able to use the full Louisiana Tourism Promotion
4	District budget as statutorily intended for the promotion of tourism.
5	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
6	does hereby designate Wednesday, April 11, 2018, as Tourism Day at the Louisiana State
7	Capitol and does hereby express appreciation and support for the fine work of the office of
8	tourism in its mission to bring visitors to Louisiana and provide ambassadorial and financial
9	benefits to the state.
10	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
11	assistant secretary of the office of tourism in the Department of Culture, Recreation and
12	Tourism.
