16 or fraudulent claim"**17** AMENDMENT NO. 7**18** On page 3, delete lines 16 through 18 in their entirety**19** AMENDMENT NO. 8**20** On page 3, at the beginning of line 19, change "D." to "C."**21** AMENDMENT NO. 9**22** On page 3, between lines 23 and 24 insert the following:**23** "D. No person shall conspire to commit a violation of Subsection A, B, or
24 C of this Section."**25** AMENDMENT NO. 10**26** On page 3, delete lines 26 through 29 in their entirety**27** AMENDMENT NO. 11**28** On page 4, between lines 19 and 20 insert the following:

1 "D. No action pursuant to this Section shall be brought unless instituted
2 within three years from the date that the facts material to the cause of action are
3 known or reasonably should have been known by the attorney general or the state
4 official charged with responsibility to act in such circumstances, but in no event
5 more than ten years from the date of the alleged violation."

6 AMENDMENT NO. 12

7 On page 4, at the beginning of line 20, change "D." to "E."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 13

9 On page 6, at the end of line 8, delete the period "." and insert a comma "," and "but no more
10 than six years after the date upon which the alleged violation occurred."
