Amendments proposed by Representative Mack to Engrossed House Bill No. 699 by Representative Stagni

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, after "to the" and before "polling" delete "oral or written"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, lines 4, after "requirements" delete the remainder of the line

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, delete lines 5 and 6 in their entirety and insert the following:

7 "for conducting a written poll of the jury; to provide for the placement of the
8 polling slips under seal; to remove the authority of the court to conduct an
9 oral poll of the jury after a verdict is rendered; and to provide for related"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, delete lines 12 through 15 in their entirety and insert the following:

12 "A. The court shall order the clerk to poll the jury if requested by the
13 state or the defendant. ~~It shall be within the discretion of the court whether~~
14 ~~such~~ The poll shall be conducted orally or in writing by applying the
15 procedures of ~~Paragraph (1) or Paragraph (2)~~ of this Article."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 5

17 On page 1, delete lines 16 through 19 in their entirety

18 AMENDMENT NO. 6

19 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 5 in their entirety

20 AMENDMENT NO. 7

21 On page 2, at the beginning of line 6, change "C.(1)" to "B.(1)"

22 AMENDMENT NO. 8

23 On page 2, line 11, after "results." delete the remainder of the line and delete line 12 in its
24 entirety

25 AMENDMENT NO. 9

26 On page 2, at the end of line 18, add the following:

1 "The polling slips may be placed under seal upon order of the court, which
2 shall state the specific reasons for placing the polling slips under seal. If so
3 ordered the polling slips shall not be released to the public without a
4 subsequent order of the court authorizing their release."
