EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

<u>REVENUE EXPLANATION</u> There will be an increase in local fund revenue by the 1% increase in bail bond premium fees collected on the amount of the bail bonds liability.

According to an official with the EBR Sheriff's department, the amount of the bail bond premium fees collected in 2017 was \$1,540,000. If the bail bonds liability remains the same, and the fee increases by 1%, an additional \$770,000 will be generated.

The estimated \$770,000 increase collected would be distributed to the following funds:

Indigent Defenders fund = \$385,000 Judicial Expense fund = \$128,333 Sheriff's general fund = \$128,333 DA operating fund = \$128,333
