<u>Proposed law</u> adds in Code of Civil Procedure that assignment of appellate panels shall be in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 13:319.

<u>Present law</u> relative to assignment and allotment of cases provides in R.S. 13:319 that each civil and criminal proceeding and each application for writs shall be randomly assigned by the clerk, subject to the direct supervision of the court. <u>Proposed law</u> changes "proceeding" to "appeal" and retains remainder of present law.

Effective August 1, 2018.

(Amends R.S. 13:319; adds C.C.P. Art. 2164.1)
