any type of civil suit or proceeding and who is not otherwise exempted by law from the payment of court costs, a sum to be determined by the judges of said the district, sitting en banc, which sum shall not exceed fifteen thirty-five dollars, subject, however, to the provisions of Louisiana Code of Civil Procedure, Article 5181, et seq. In all criminal cases over which the Fifteenth Judicial District Court has jurisdiction, there shall be taxed as costs against every defendant who is convicted after trial or after plea of guilty or who forfeits his bond, a sum likewise determined, but which shall not exceed five twenty dollars and which shall be in addition to all other fines, costs, or forfeitures lawfully imposed and which shall be transmitted to the said clerk for further disposition in accordance herewith with the provisions of this Section.

Abstract: Provides for an increase in civil and criminal court costs in the 15th JDC and requires the judges to set the fees to be paid to the court reporter.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the 15th JDC to collect a filing fee no greater than \$15 in all civil court matters. Provides for the assessment of criminal court costs not to exceed \$5. Additionally, in all civil and criminal cases, there is a fee not to exceed \$1.50 per 31-line page and 25 cents per copy reported and transcribed to be paid to the court reporter as compensation, in addition to the court reporter salary.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the criminal court fee assessed to certain defendants <u>from</u> a sum no greater than \$5 <u>to</u> a sum not to exceed \$20 dollars. Also increases the civil court filing fees <u>from</u> a sum no greater than \$15 <u>to</u> a sum not to exceed \$35. Additionally, requires the fee amounts for transcripts and copies to be determined by a majority vote of the judges in the 15th JDC to be paid to the court reporters in addition to their salary.
