1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, delete "R.S. 39:2006(A)(4)" and insert "R.S. 39:2006(A)(4), 2175(5) and  
3 (6)," and after "to" and before "the" insert "entrepreneurships of"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 3, after "and the" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu thereof  
6 "Veteran Initiative;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 4, delete "Veteran-Owned Small Entrepreneurships;"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 1, line 5, after "entrepreneurships;" insert "to provide relative to the percent of  
11 evaluation points awarded to certain veterans in requests for proposals;"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 On page 1, line 9, delete "and R.S. 39:2176(A)(4)" and insert a comma "," and "2175(5) and  
14 (6), and 2176(A)(4)"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 6

16 On page 2, between lines 6 and 7, insert the following:

17        "§2175. Competitive source selection

18                Methods of source selection which may be utilized by an agency to satisfy  
19 a state goal for contracting with veteran and service-connected disabled  
20 veteran-owned small entrepreneurships shall include but not be limited to:

21                (5) An allowance for at least ~~ten~~ twelve percent of the total evaluation points  
22 in a request for proposal be awarded to an offeror demonstrating a good faith effort  
23 to use veteran and service-connected disabled veteran-owned small  
24 entrepreneurships as subcontractors.

25                (6) ~~Ten~~ Twelve percent of the total evaluation points in a request for  
26 proposal shall be awarded to an offeror who is a certified veteran and  
27 service-connected disabled veteran-owned small business entrepreneurship. The  
28 mandatory award of evaluation points required by this Paragraph shall be included  
29 in all requests for proposals, unless the inclusion jeopardizes funding for the  
30 procurement or violates any other provision of law. Any request for an exemption  
31 from the requirements of this Paragraph shall be submitted in writing to the  
32 commissioner of administration who shall either deny or approve the request. The  
33

1 provisions of this Paragraph shall not apply to design-build or construction manager  
2 at risk methods of construction."
