Amendments proposed by Representative Henry in the Committee of the Whole House to Engrossed House Bill No. 1 by Representative Henry

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1**2** On page 27, line 19, change "13,007,996" to "13,007,966"**3** AMENDMENT NO. 2**4** On page 27, line 21, change "13,007,996" to "13,007,966"**5** AMENDMENT NO. 3**6** On page 80, between lines 39 and 40, insert the following:

7 "Beginning on October 1, 2018, and monthly thereafter, the department shall submit a report
8 detailing the programmatic allocations of the total appropriated for Schedule 09-306 Medical
9 Vendor Payments in this Act to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget for its review.
10 The first report shall include a detailed itemization of the actual means of financing and
11 expenditures for Medical Vendor Payments in Fiscal Year 2017-2018 and the initial
12 allocation of payments for Fiscal Year 2018-2019 to provider groups, state agencies, or
13 managed care programs within each of the four programs: Payments to Private Providers;
14 Payments to Public Providers; Medicare Buy-Ins and Supplements; and Uncompensated
15 Care Costs. The first report shall also include, for both the prior and current fiscal year, an
16 itemization of supplemental payments and uncompensated care costs payments to the LSU
17 Public Private Partnership hospitals. The second report, and each subsequent report
18 thereafter, shall itemize the projected expenditures in Fiscal Year 2018-2019 for each
19 allocation within the four programs and payments to the public private partnership hospital
20 as presented in the first report of the fiscal year. Also, the reports shall include a section
21 specifying the total amount of pharmacy rebates received year-to-date and the total amount
22 projected to be received by the end of the fiscal year. Further, the department shall include
23 a section in each report detailing the anticipated levels of revenue collections in Medical
24 Vendor Payments by source and, in the event a deficit is projected, any other sources of
25 revenues that may be available or adjustments in expenditures that could be implemented
26 within the department to aid in alleviating the projected deficit. Finally, the department may
27 vary the forecasting methodologies utilized to produce the reports as necessary to ensure the
28 submission of the most accurate projections of revenues and expenditures as practical."

29 AMENDMENT NO. 4**30** On page 81, between lines 24 and 25, insert the following:

31 "The Louisiana Department of Health shall not reduce reimbursement rates for providers
32 rendering applied behavioral analysis services, including any rates agreed upon in any
33 contractual agreement with a managed care organization, as defined in 42 CFR 483.2, that
34 transfers the provision of applied behavioral analysis services to a managed care
35 organization."

36 AMENDMENT NO. 5**37** On page 88, delete lines 8 and 9 in their entirety and insert the following:

38 "Cost reports shall not include any attorney fees paid by public/private partnership hospitals
39 for any anti-trust lawsuits against the state or any public or private entity."
