A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To recognize Tuesday, May 1, 2018, as Acadiana Day at the state capitol.

WHEREAS, the Acadiana region's business community comes to the legislature annually to advocate for priorities that will improve the economic competitiveness of the parishes; and

WHEREAS, the success of Acadiana's regional business community is due to its partnerships with economic, civic, and educational partners; and
