(KEYWORD, SUMMARY, AND DIGEST as amended by Senate committee amendments)

SANITARY CODE: Provides relative to water system testing at certain businesses which apply for or hold retail food permits.

DIGEST

Present law provides that in order to protect the public health, the state health officer shall promulgate rules and regulations relative to retail food establishments.

Proposed law stipulates that the requirements of the sanitary code shall not apply to a water supply that services a retail food establishment that does not meet the definition of a "public water system" as defined in present law.

(Amends R.S. 40:4(A)(1)(c))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to the original bill:

1. Revise proposed law to provide that the rules and regulations required by present law relative to regulation of retail food establishments shall not apply to a retail food establishment which is open to the public for fewer than 180 days per year and has a water system with fewer than 15 service connections.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to the engrossed bill

1. Provides that the requirements in the sanitary code shall not apply to a water supply that services a retail food establishment that does not meet the definition of a "public water system" as defined in present law.
