LAW ENFORCE/OFFICERS: Provides with respect to financial security for survivors of federal law enforcement officers

2	To enact R.S. 40:1665.2(B)(17) and (C)(4), relative to survivors of law enforcement officers			
3	killed while performing their duties; to provide for financial benefits for survivor			
4	of federal law enforcement agents killed in Louisiana; and to provide for related			
5	matters.			
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:			
7	Section 1. This Act shall be known as the "Deputy Marshal Josie Wells Act".			
8	Section 2. R.S. 40:1665.2(B)(17) and (C)(4) are hereby enacted to read as follows			
9	§1665.2. Financial security for surviving spouses and children of law enforcement			
10	officers in certain cases

6	Section 3. This Act shall be given retroactive effect to March 1, 2015, and		
7	prospective effect.		
8	Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not		
9	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature		
10	by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If		
1	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become		
12	effective on the day following such approval.

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Abstract: Adds federal law enforcement officers killed while enforcing La. law in La. to those officers whose survivors are entitled to \$250,000 if the officer is killed in performing his duties.

<u>Present law</u> provides for payment of \$250,000 to the surviving spouse, child, or other beneficiary of a law enforcement officer who suffers death as a result of an injury arising out of and in the course of the performance of his official duties or arising out of any activity in his capacity as an officer in the protection of life and property. Provides that such payments are made from the state's self-insurance fund. Specifies groups of law enforcement officers to whom <u>present law</u> is applicable.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that <u>present law</u> is applicable to federal law enforcement officers or employees whose permanent duties include making arrests, performing searches and seizures, executing criminal arrest warrants, and executing civil seizure warrants and who are killed while enforcing La. law in La.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that <u>proposed law</u> shall be given retroactive effect to March 1, 2015, and prospective effect.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
