Prohibits a person convicted of a hate crime from possessing a firearm or carrying a concealed weapon

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits individuals convicted of a hate crime from possessing a firearm or carrying a concealed weapon, if the underlying offense for the hate crime is a felony. <u>Proposed law</u> provides for criminal penalties and exceptions. <u>Proposed law</u> defines "firearm".

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

<u>Proposed law</u> may result in an indeterminable increase in SGF expenditures in the Department of Public Safety and Corrections – Corrections Services if a certain person convicted of a hate crime is subsequently convicted of possession of a firearm or carrying of a concealed weapon, if the underlying offense for the hate crime is a felony. The maximum imprisonment term is five (5) years, with or without hard labor.

SGF expenditures will increase by \$54.21 per offender per day if an offender is housed in a state facility or \$24.39 for a state offender housed in a local facility. An offender sentenced to the custody of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections - Correction Services for one year would increase SGF expenditures by \$19,786.65 (\$54.21 per day x 365 days) if housed in a state facility and \$8,902.35 (\$24.39 per day x 365 days) if housed in a local facility. Approximately 50% of state offenders are housed in local facilities.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

<u>Proposed law</u> may result in an indeterminable increase in local funds revenue as a result of potential fines if certain persons convicted of a hate crime is subsequently convicted of possession of a firearm or carrying of a concealed weapon, if the underlying offense for the hate crime is a felony. The maximum fines assessed are \$1,000. The potential revenue will accrue to the local governing authority.
