FUNDS/FUNDING EG SEE FISC NOTE SD RV See Note Page 1 of 2 Provides for reduction to revenues into certain statutory funds to newly established TOPS Stability Fund.

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes the TOPS Stability Fund as a special treasury fund. Monies in the fund shall be used to provide funding for TOPS and invested in the same manner as the state general fund. Unexpended and unencumbered monies remain in the fund at the end of the fiscal year. <u>Proposed law</u> reduces 50% of monies deposited into the Casino Support Services Fund, Compulsive And Problem Gaming Fund, Dept of Revenue Alcohol and Tobacco Control Officers Fund, LA Agricultural Finance Authority Fund, Louisiana Economic Development Fund, Marketing Fund, New Orleans Sports Franchise Fund, Pari-Mutuel Live Racing Facility Gaming Control Fund, Riverboat Gaming Enforcement Fund, Tobacco Regulation Enforcement Fund, and Tobacco Tax Health Care Fund. These monies are to deposited into the TOPS Stability Fund. Effective July 1, 2018.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Proposed legislation will result in an indeterminable change in state expenditures. This measure does not eliminate the existing expenditures currently supported by these dedications; however, to the extent other revenue sources are not available, expenditures will be reduced. See **page 2** for list of departments that are appropriated funds out of these statutory dedications.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

Proposed legislation will result in a net zero change in state revenues, but will redirect approximately \$89.8 M - \$96.0 M into this newly created statutory dedication (TOPS Stability Fund) that otherwise would have been deposited into a statutory dedication or classified as SGF (Pari-Mutuel Live Racing Facility Gaming Control Fund). This range is based on two different methodologies: 1) FY 19 REC forecast: based on the 12/14/17 Revenue Estimating Conference (REC) projections for FY 19, \$179.7 M is forecasted from the impacted funds that would be redirected to the TOPS Stability Fund. 2) Five-year average of deposits: based on the last five years (FY 13 - 17), there was an average of \$193.1 M deposited in these specific statutory dedications. Assuming these deposits remain constant, this legislation would deposit between \$89.8 M - \$96.0 M into the TOPS Stability Fund beginning in FY 19 and subsequent years.

Note: The Pari-Mutuel Live Racing Facility Gaming Control Fund racing slots machine tax proceeds are distributed to several statutory dedications and the remaining balance is reverted to the state general fund. This measure will reduce the revenues these funds receive from the Pari-Mutuel fund and the amount classified as SGF. Over the last five years (FY 13 - FY 17), an average of \$23.8 M from this fund has been classified as SGF.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> This measure will reduce by half the available funding in the Pari-Mutuel Live Racing Facility Gaming Control Fund that is distributed to other statutory dedications. However, the statute (27:392) pertaining to the allocation of these monies provides for either a set amount or a percentage allocation of available funding. Therefore, this measure will likely not reduce these statutory dedications by an even 50% and is anticipated to reduce the amount of monies that are reverted to the state general fund by an amount greater than 50%.
